## Biographical and Other Notes

The collection was principally formed by the Derbyshire landowner and amateur archaeologist Thomas Bateman (1821–61), but included a small portion inherited from his grandfather, William Bateman (1787–1835). It contained material found by both during local excavations, as well as objects bought by Thomas from other sources. After the death of Thomas's son, William Thomas Bateman, the collection was sold by order of the Court of Chancery (Sotheby 4-6 May 1893).
