Biographical and Other Notes

A Norfolk landowner and antiquary who was a member and vice-president of the Spalding Gentlemen's Society. He bequeathed his coins to Trinity College; a manuscript catalogue of his collection, probably written by Charles Mason (1699–1771), Fellow of Trinity and Professor of Geology 1734–62. Was working on a book about Roman Coins when he died, remains unpublished.
