### **Biographical and Other Notes**

Born in Marlborough, Wiltshire and educated locally, he joined British Rail in 1961 at Witney station. Later he moved to Reading and worked with early computers on rolling stock logistics. Nerve injury and compensation led to early retirement in 1999. A pioneering collector of banknotes, starting in the 1960s, he collected from over 180 countries.

His collections were sold through DNW: 13 April 2010 and 30 September 2010.
