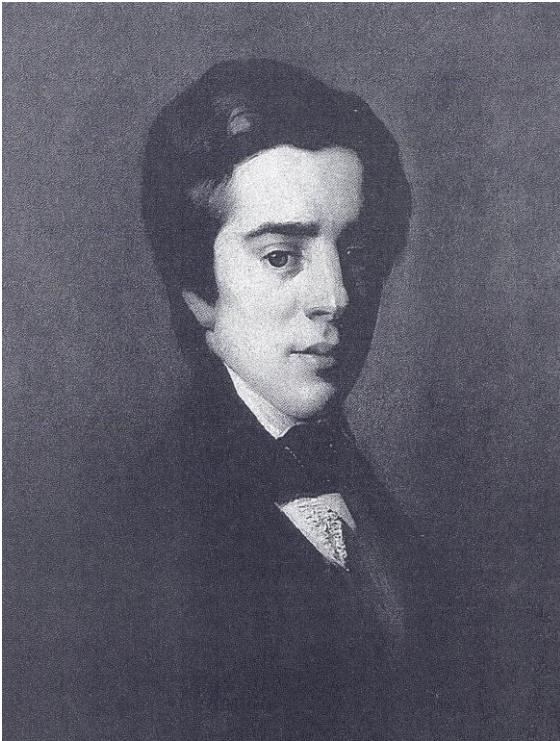


Feuardent, Félix Bienaimé

Biographical and Other Notes

Charles Louis Rollin (1777-1853) dealing in coins since 1800 and went into partnership with Feuardent after 1830, with shops in Paris and London. Feuardent had originally worked as a librarian and had married Rollin's daughter. Took over the late George Eastwood's London premises after 1866 'dealers in coins, gems, antiquities, & numismatic books.'

On his death, his three sons took over the business. Catalogue of 15,000 mereaux and jetons published in 1904, reprinted many times, collections sold 1928/9.
