### Biographical and Other Notes

He started collecting in 1930 and continued with difficulty during the war. In 1946 he founded the *Kölner Universitätsverlag* publishing house. He sold this in 1964 and focused on his collection of banknotes. He transferred his collection of 180,000 notes to what is now known as the HypoVereins Bank and became their curator with a budget that allowed the collection to increase to 300,000 items. He produced a few banknote catalogues in the 60s and 70s and then in 1975 *The Standard Catalogue of World Paper Money*.
