Born in Rutherford, New Jersey to a family of horticulturalists. His father was an orchid collector. Edward travelled around the Caribbean for the business and set up a specialist plantation in Arecibo, Puerto Rico in 1949. His interest in Caribbean tokens and tallies grew into all numismatic aspects of the area.
