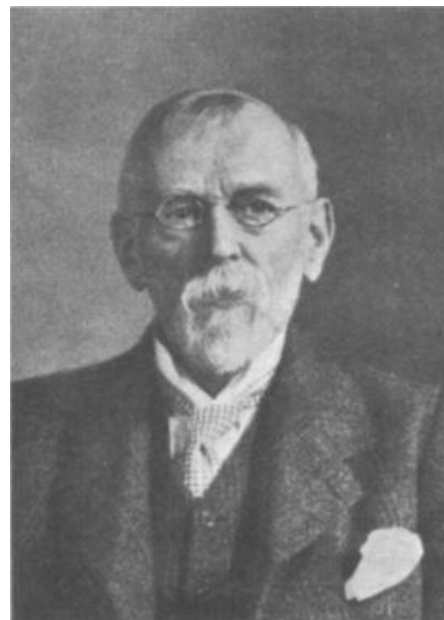


Roth, Henry 'Ling'

Biographical and Other Notes

Son of Dr. Mathias Roth of Harley St., London. Four of his five brothers went into medicine. Henry was an accountant and anthropologist. Curator of the Bankfield Museum, Halifax, 1900-1912, then keeper. Wrote and compiled *The Yorkshire Coiners 1767-1783. And Notes on Old and Prehistoric Halifax* (Halifax, 1906). He travelled all over the world and is best known for his ethnographic studies of Australia and Tasmania.
