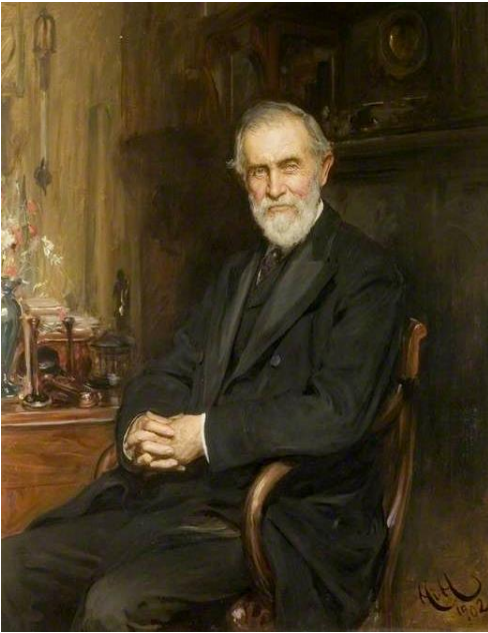

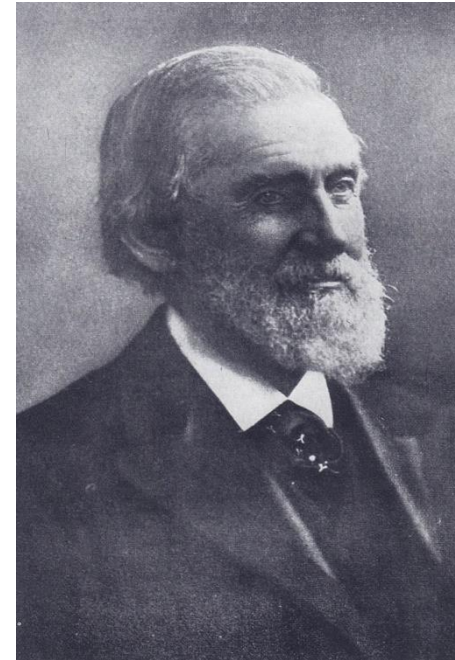
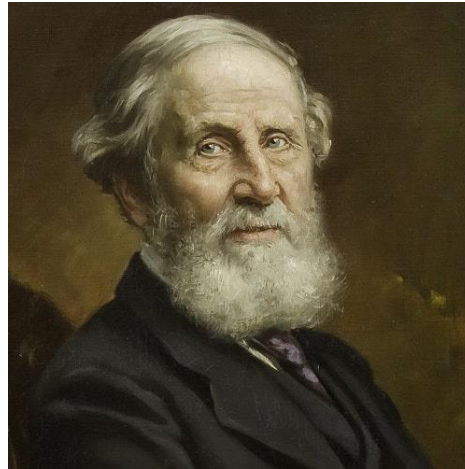

Biographical and Other Notes

Born Holzkirchen, Upper Bavaria, Bavaria, Germany. Trained as a physician, and came to England in pursuit of his interest in the works of Shakespeare. NSL/RNS various posts. Built and sold several collections. His final collection of Greek was divided between the BM and Spink & Son. The latter pieces went to Virgil M. Brand and the collection was catalogued by L. Forrer in three volumes 1922-29 (8953 coins and 317 plates)
