Biographical and Other Notes

He was given his first coin at the age of seven and was buying from dealers from the age of 10. Wrote many articles and won several prizes, mostly on American numismatic topics. He also wrote pioneering books such as *The Early Paper Money of America* (1967). Collections sold in over 19,000 lots through Heritage Auctions, realizing over \$72M, to be used for scholarly numismatic research and other not for profit activities.

One of the products is the Newman Numismatic Portal which is digitizing vast quantities of historical coin sales and auction catalogues. Though mostly USA focused, Glendining's, Spink and Sotheby's etc. etc. are available for free.
