## Biographical and Other Notes

Born Clitheroe, Lancashire. First coin aged 8, focused on regal shillings 1978. Physics degree at York University, PhD and post doc at Cranfield institute of Technology followed by 24 years, at Schlumberger Cambridge Research. Scientific advisor in oilfield fluid mechanics. Took early retirement in 2020. First shilling tokens in 1986 followed by tokens of local counties (Beds, Hunts, Cambs), counterfeits, ephemera, and postal orders. Past editor of TCSB and co-organiser of four Token Congresses. Various societies: Burnley & Dist., York, Bedford, Cambridge, BNS and RNS. Many lectures, articles and notes published and one book (Beds 17<sup>th</sup> C tokens, with John Gaunt). Contributors to British Numismatics
