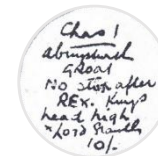


Willis, Frederick

Biographical and Other Notes

Of Birmingham. Family steel manufacturing firm, Willis & Co, West Bromwich, Staffordshire. Small lots of coins through Glendining's 1956-62. Suffered a violent robbery in 1976 where gold and specimen sets were stolen. His widow sold his English hammered and milled silver: Edward III to Elizabeth II, at Glendining's in 547 lots 5 June 1991 and 844 lots 7 October 1991.
