Biographical and Other Notes

Born in Wincanton, Somerset, appears as a stationer in Edgbaston, Birmingham in the 1861 census. Later censuses have him as a commercial traveller for a paper mill. He left £1480 9s 11d in his will in 1921.

With W.J. Davis he financed the New Centenary tokens, issued by subscription at 2s. each and which helped publicise Davis' *The Token Coinage of Warwickshire* (Birmingham, 1895), which was being compiled at the time the tokens made their appearance. Appears in Davis' gallery of contemporary collectors.
