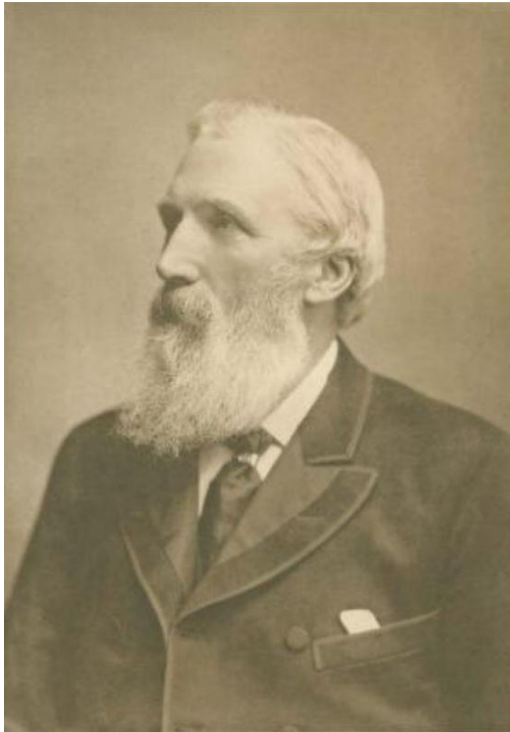
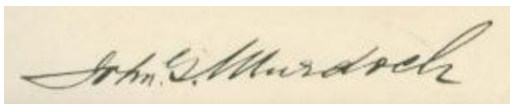

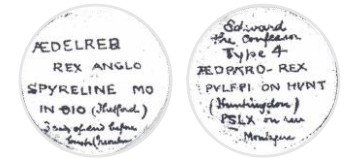

Biographical and Other Notes

Born at Huntingtower, Perthshire. Apprenticed in block cutting and printing and a second apprenticeship in machine printing. Religious publisher and pianoforte manufacturer. NSL. Rival to Hyman Montague. Sold his duplicates: English patterns and proofs, colonial, English medals etc. in 298 lots at Sotheby's 12-13 February 1889. Main collections sold after his death by Sotheby's in eight parts from 31 March- 4 April 1903 to 12-13 December 1904. Each auction lasting 2-3 days.
