Born Joan E.L. Clarke. After Dulwich High School she attended Newnham College Cambridge and left a wrangler with a double first in mathematics. Recruited during the Second World War as a codebreaker at Bletchley Park. Later employed at Government Communications Headquarters (GCHQ), Cheltenham. Wife of J.K.R. Murray. BNS, council and medal. Wrote many articles on Scottish coinage.
