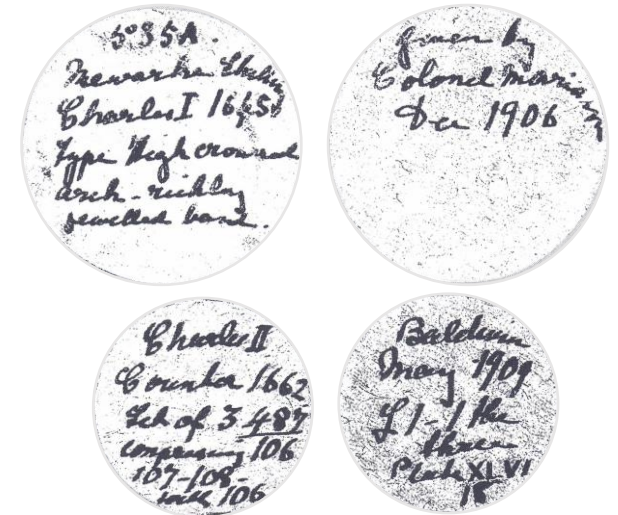

## Biographical and Other Notes

Of independent means, living in London. Founder member of the BNS. Specialised in Tudor, Stuart and Jacobite portraiture and badges. Many published articles on these topics. On her death she left 50 pieces, including a Truro Unite to the BM and the rest of the collection was sold anonymously through Glendining's on 25 April 1955 for £6,600.
