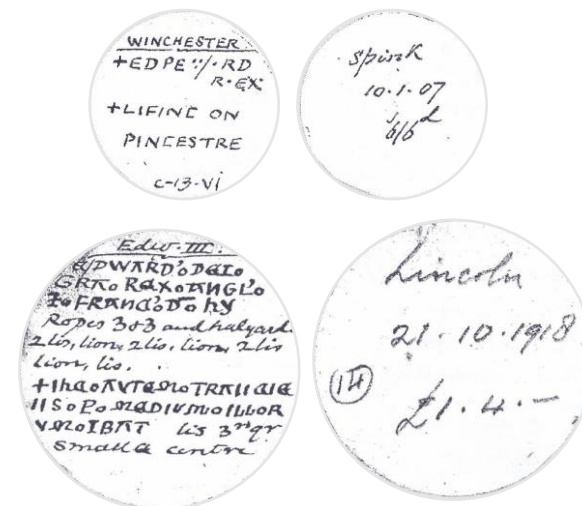
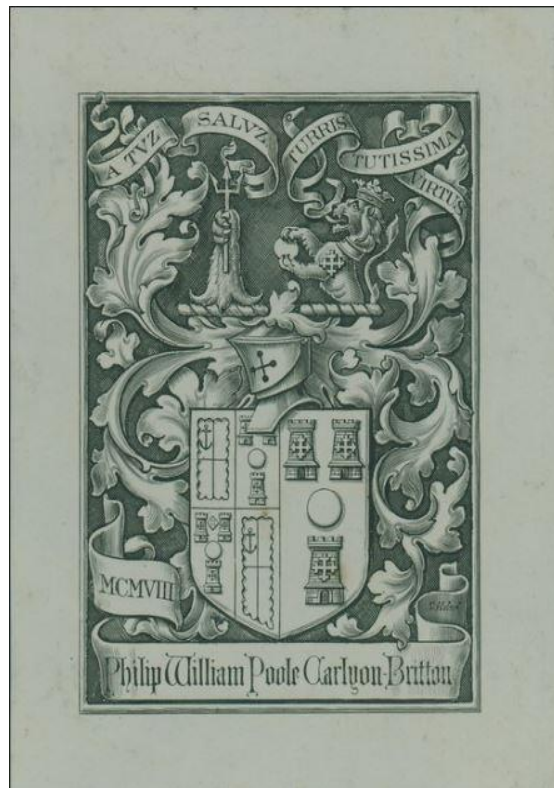

Biographical and Other Notes

Solicitor, initially a member of the RNS, founder member of the BNS, later President, Vice-President etc., and joint editor of the BNJ for vols. 1-10. Many published papers and notes. Collections of Celtic, Romano-British, Anglo-Saxon and Norman were auctioned before 1918 including the Offa Mancus. After 1918, there is some confusion between the father and son's collections. A portion was purchased by H.A. Seaby (at Spink) in 1922 and collections of hammered and milled gold were sold through Seaby 1938-40 onwards. Father of Raymond Carlyon Britton. (HEM 4 suggests PWP's father and grandfather were collectors, but no evidence.)
