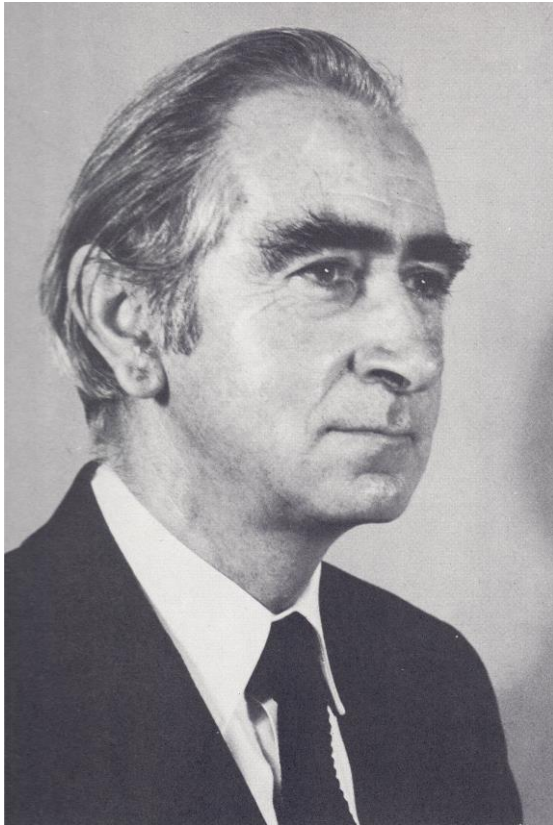
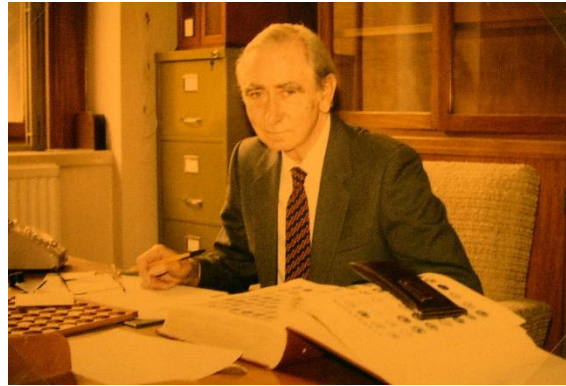

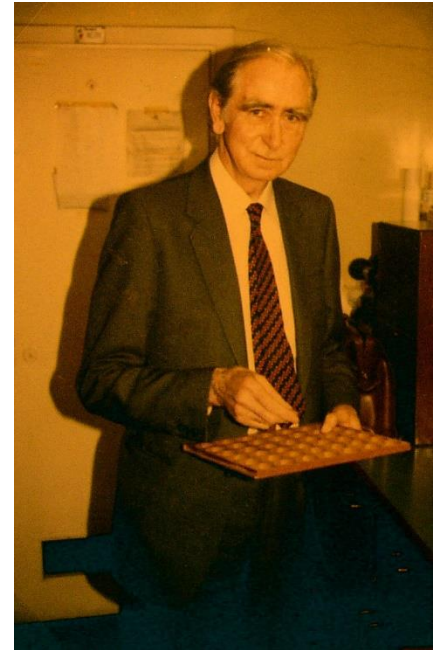

## Biographical and Other Notes

Specialist of Roman coinage. Born in Kirkcudbright 1918; educated in Classics at Glasgow University; served in the Royal Artillery in the Second World War, and appointed a curator in the Department of Coins and Medals in the British Museum in 1947; became Deputy Keeper in 1965, then Keeper in 1978; retired 1983. Served as President of the Royal Numismatic Society, 1975-79, and co-author with Hugh Pagan of the 'History of the Royal Numismatic Society' (published 1986); appointed Fellow of the British Academy 1980. Retired to Australia where died in Sydney, 24 March 2006. Author of 'Coins of the Roman Empire in the British Museum, vol. VI', plus 'Late Roman Bronze Coinage' (1960, co-author), 'Coins' (1962), and 'Coins of the Roman Empire'. (BM).
