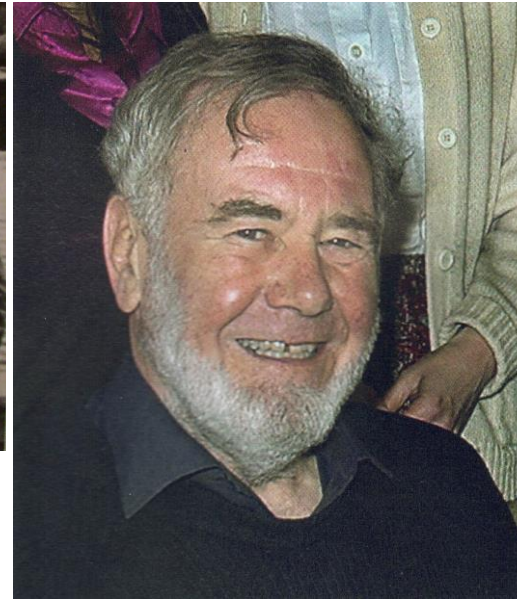

Biographical and Other Notes

Born in Gillingham, Kent. During the second world war he was fascinated by Rochester Museum. His interest in the Fitzwilliam began at the end of the second world war, when his family moved to Cambridge. After national service (1948-50), he returned to the museum and began his long association with the coin room. He continued working there part time while reading history at Pembroke College. From 1954, he was junior assistant keeper; in 1966, he became keeper of coins and medals; and from 1969 until 1988, he was deputy director of the museum. Founder member of the British Art Medals Society and specialist in Renaissance medals.
