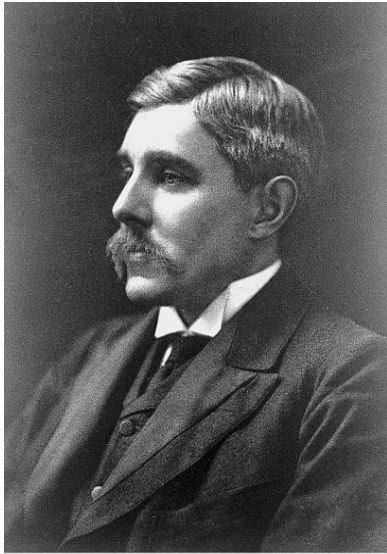

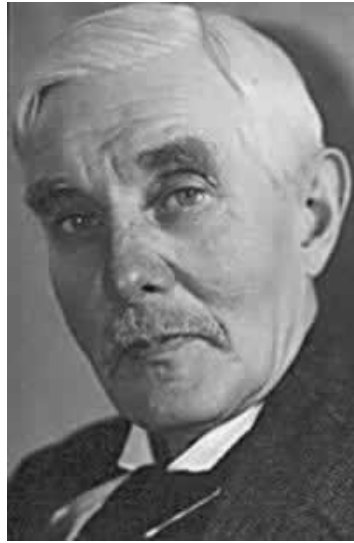

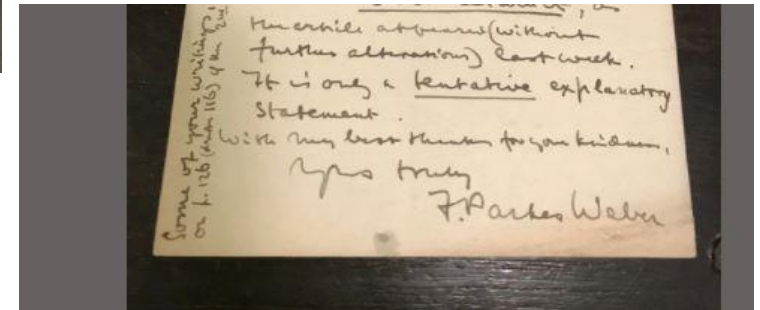

Biographical and Other Notes

A London physician and dermatologist, son of Sir Hermann Weber and writer on a wide variety of subjects. LNS/RNS, BNS, several short publications and also books on unusual numismatic topics, e.g. Aspects of Death and their effects on the living, as illustrated by minor works of art, especially medals, engraved gems etc. initially SNC then a book in 1914. Donated 5551 coins to the BM, some to the Bodleian Library and others to The Fitzwilliam Museum.
