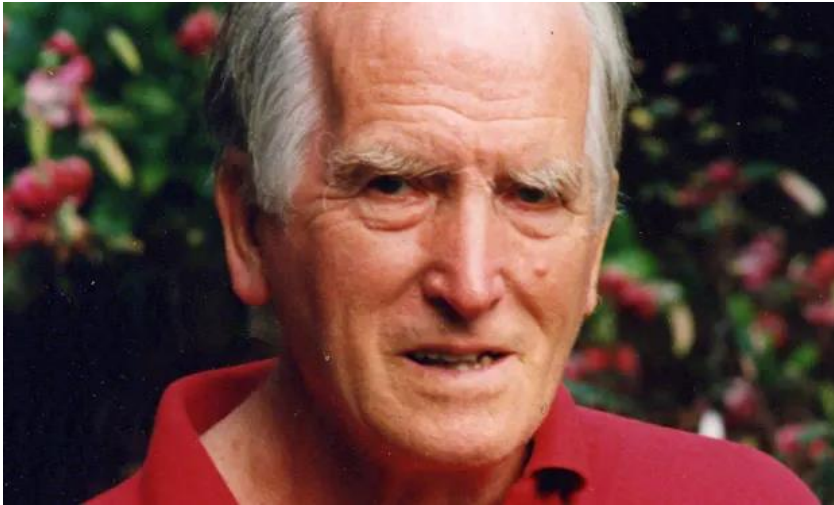

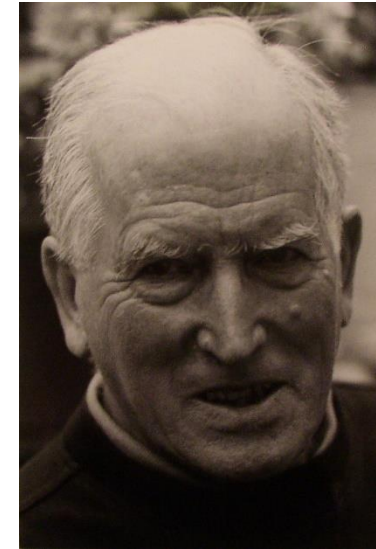

Biographical and Other Notes

Born in Finchley, East London, son of Harold Mattingly, keeper of Roman coins at the British Museum. After Leys school in Cambridge, Harold Jr achieved a double first in classics at Cambridge, becoming a lecturer (then reader) in ancient history at the University of Nottingham, before moving in 1970 to be a professor in ancient history at Leeds University. Prolific author on classical Greece and the Roman republic, and on the study of inscriptions and coins. Collected works run to three volumes. President of the RNS 1999-2004. In retirement he continued his work in the Classics Faculty Library in Cambridge.
