Biographical and Other Notes

An English peer and banker from the Child-Villiers family, much is unknown about the 9th Earl of Jersey as a numismatist but research is ongoing. His extensive collection, now in the hands of the National Trust at Osterley Park, Middlesex, indicates an avid and broad collector with a particular interest in English medieval and early modern coinages and ancient Greek and Roman numismatics. Leaving Osterley Park and House to the National Trust in 1949, he later bequeathed his coin collection to the same in the 1990s.
