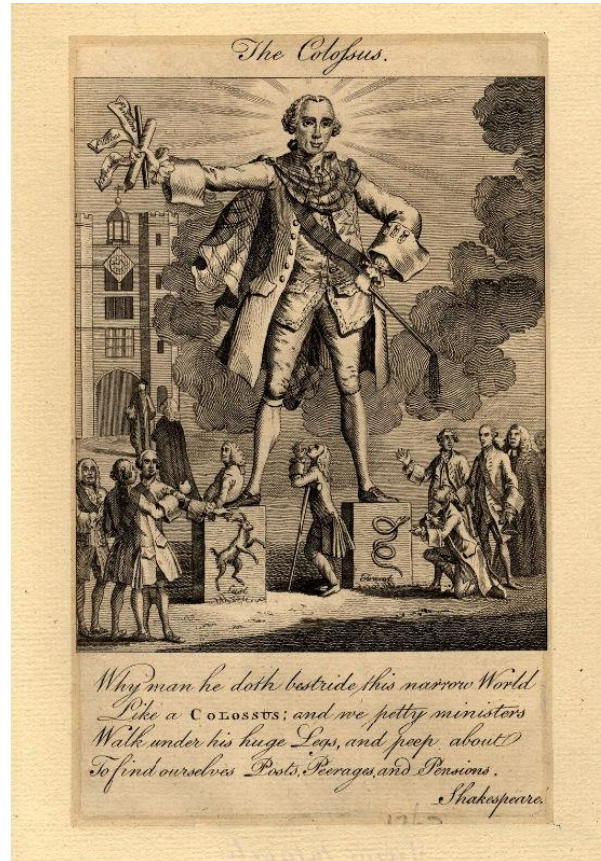

**Biographical and Other Notes**

A large collection formed in the eighteenth century by the 3rd Earl (who served briefly as Prime Minister 1762–3) was supplemented by his heirs, down to the time of the 2nd Marquess (John Crichton-Stuart (1793–1848)). It consisted largely of medals, together with a number of English and European coins. Three sales were held when the collection was dispersed by the 5th Marquess (John Crichton-Stuart (1907–56)) (Sotheby 7 May 1951, 11 June 1951 and Glendining's 12 May 1959.
