Biographical and Other Notes

Babington was a Professor of Botany at Cambridge University from 1861 to 1895. He was equally productive in Botany and Archaeology. He was a founding member of the Cambridge Antiquarian Society in 1840 to which he contributed over 50 papers. Amongst these was the first county catalogue of Cambridgeshire 17th Century tokens. Which begins "We should perhaps be hardly justified in considering the study of the subjects of this paper as forming a department of Numismatics, as they can scarcely be considered as Coins or Medals; and there is not a trace of beauty in their execution."
