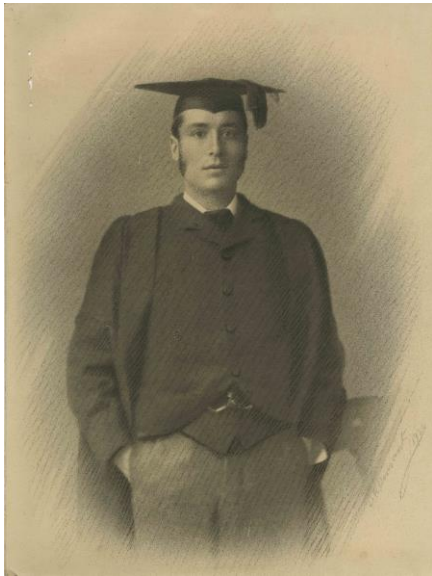


Barnard, Francis Pierrepont

Biographical and Other Notes

BA, MA Pembroke College Oxford, Headmaster at Reading School, later Professor of Mediaeval Archaeology, University of Liverpool. Pioneering work on the Casting Counter and Counting Board (1916). Huge collection of jettons required a truck to transport it when donated to the Ashmolean Museum in 1931, and FPB insisted on an armed guard! He is buried at Wolvercote cemetery, Oxford. His first wife was Eliza Smith Pollard and his second wife was her sister Isabella Smith Pollard. Both were daughters of a cotton manufacturer and co-heiresses of St. Mary's Abbey, Windermere.
