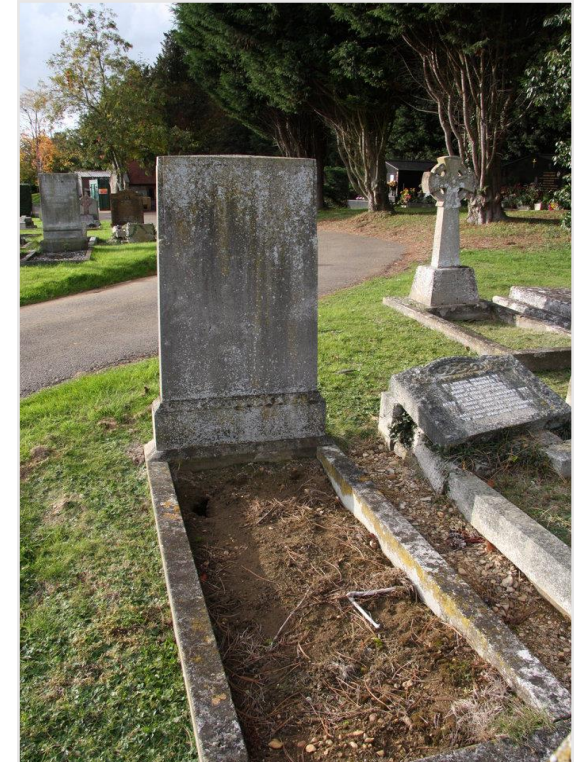


Barnard, Isabella ('Ella') Pierrepont

(1864-1934)



Biographical and Other Notes

Born Isabella Smith Pollard, she was the second wife of FP Barnard. She was the daughter of a cotton manufacturer and co-heiresses of St. Mary's Abbey, Windermere, with her sister.

She is buried with her husband at Wolvercote Cemetery, Oxford. The gravestone describes Isabella Smith Barnard as "his friend his lover and his wife". Her collection of engraved coins was written up in the BNJ in 1918 and was sold as a single lot at Sotheby's in 1934. Bought by Paul Tinchant (1893-1981), most entered the BM in 1952.
