Biographical and Other Notes

Born in Sudbury, Ontario and came to England in 1928. After serving in the RCAF 1945-48 he returned to England to take up a consultancy post in the plastic surgery unit of Shotley Bridge General Hospital in county Durham. He had collected since the age of 5, and from the 1950s to 1970s concentrated on Tradesmens tokens from the 18th and 19th C. He corresponded widely and wrote several books, mostly illustrated with pieces from his own collections, including the first catalogue of unofficial farthings. His 1,800 tokens sold in 311 lots through DNW 1 October 1996.
