Born in Eyebury, Peterborough. Uppingham School followed by Classics at Magdalene College, Cambridge. Cadet in the Federated Malay States Civil Service, including China. In 1903 ill health ended this career, but five years' convalescence developed an interest in geology and archaeology. Ashmolean Museum: Assistant Keeper 1908-27, Keeper 1928-45. Author of 'Oxford Tradesmen's Tokens' in *Surveys and Tokens* Oxford Historical Society Vol. 75, 1923.
