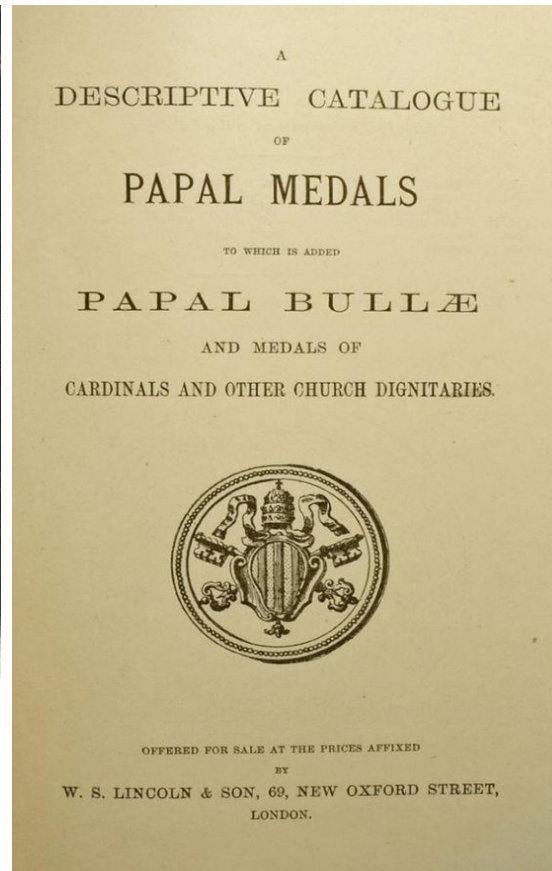

## Biographical and Other Notes

Firm with premises at 69 New Oxford St, London. William Simpson Lincoln born Yarmouth in Norfolk (1803-1872, bookseller &c in 1851 and 1861, London census). Various addresses in London. Headed successively by Frederick William Lincoln (1830-1909, dealer in antiquities in 1881 census, numismatist, and antiquarian in 1901 census), and by his son Frederick William Lincoln jr. (1857-1928, assistant to his father in 1881 census). The firm was carried on until about 1932 by a third Frederick William Lincoln when the business failed.
