



**Biographical and Other Notes**

Landowner Fovey, Cornwall. Inherited family coin collection begun by his great-uncle Philip Rashleigh (1729-1811). This included 70 Anglo-Saxon pennies from the Trewiddle hoard. Collected mainly Anglo-Saxon, Norman and later English hammered. Collection passed to his son Evelyn William Rashleigh, then sold in 1185 lots over nine days at Sotheby's 21 June - 1 July 1909. A further group of Civil War badges and medals attributed to E.W. Rashleigh at Sotheby's 26-27 July 1920.
