



## Biographical and Other Notes

Solicitor, Argyll St., London, lived Redstone Manor House, Reigate, Surrey. NSL. Sale of duplicate English coins in 273 lots at Sotheby's 6-7 August 1885. Primary collection: Conquest to Victoria, Sotheby's 870 lots 9-14 July 1894, second part: Anglo-Saxon, English, Scottish, Irish, Anglo-Gallic and Anglo-Colonial in 442 lots at Sotheby's 25-27 July 1895. Whilst there were some forgeries, there were many important coins, including J.F. Neck's collection, bought by private treaty. Left £50,846 12s 8d in his will
