### **Biographical and Other Notes**

He was born in Berne, Switzerland. He did well at school but was rejected for military service. He came to England in 1938 and started to walk around the country, befriending many along the way. At the outbreak of war he was recalled to London by the Swiss embassy and he began working for UBS in London in late 1939. He retired from his post as Chief Inspector in 1974 after 35 years' service. From his first coin given by an uncle in the 1920s, he built most of his collection in the 1940s and 1950s.
