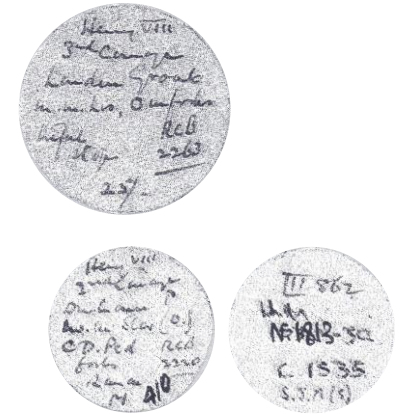


Whitton, Cuthbert Alexander

Biographical and Other Notes

Born in Seaforth, Lancashire, 1899. Aged 21 he was a Bank Clerk at nearby New Ferry in Cheshire. Then Schoolmaster at Newcastle under Lyme High School. Retired early due to ill health and moved to Wellingborough. RNS and BNS where he edited the BNJ from vol. 23 part ii to vol. 26 part i. Author of any articles in NC and BNJ ranging Henry III to James I. Much of his collection of British, English and Foreign coins sold in 176 lots at Glendining 5 October 1943. English hammered silver was bought by Seaby and appeared in SCMB 1950-51.
