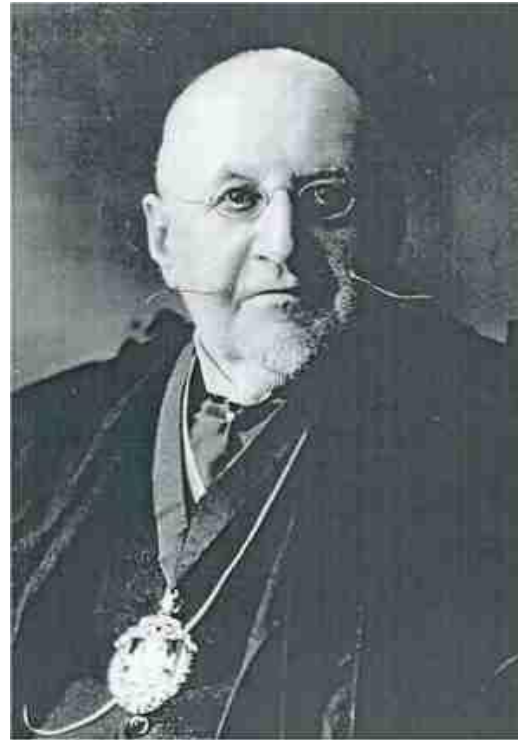


**Williamson, George Charles**

### **Biographical and Other Notes**

Born in Guildford, Surrey, educated at London University and an art historian by profession. Many publications in the art world, especially on portrait miniatures. Also many publications on Guildford history, coins, tokens and archaeology. Most remembered for editing a two-volume catalogue of 17<sup>th</sup>C tokens, bringing together the works of many county specialists. Collection of 17<sup>th</sup>C tokens and Anglo-Saxon and Norman coins of Guildford and 18<sup>th</sup> C tokens sold through Sotheby 27-28 February 1908.
