Biographical and Other Notes

David Wratten was born in Crayford near Dartford in Kent in 1935. Passion for family history that began in the 1970's. He joined the Cambridge Family History Society, holding several posts and being pivotal in projects to transcribe the county's records. Small collection of about 25 tokens from the town of Cambridge, mostly metal detector finds acquired from Alan Fordham at the Cambridge Coin Shop on Bridge Street, now with G. Oddie. Extensive research notes on Cambridgeshire 17th C token issuers, some published in TCSB (1994-1997), which formed the seed for G. Oddie's forthcoming book.
