Notes on Gift Aid

1) Please note that to qualify for Gift Aid, tax can only be reclaimed on donations made by individuals who pay UK income or capital gains tax at least equal to the amount reclaimed on their donations in the current tax year.

2) **Basic Rate Tax Payers.** If you pay tax at the basic rate of 22%, the Society can reclaim the tax paid on your donation, which amounts to £28.21 on every £100 donated.

2) **Higher Rate Tax Payers.** If you pay tax at the higher rate, you can also claim tax relief on at 18% (i.e. the difference between the higher rate of tax at 40% and the basic rate at 22%) on the gross value via your Self Assessment tax form. For example, if you give £100 we can reclaim an extra £28.21 for the Society and you can reclaim another £23.08. As a result, a £100 gift worth £128.21 to the Society only costs you £76.92.
