Biographical and Other Notes

A solicitor and alderman of Brighton who studied at Cambridge. He was the brother of the Egyptologist Francis Llewellyn Griffith. Griffith collected widely, and gave most of his acquisitions to Brighton museums, but a small number of coins minted in Cambridge and once owned by him are now in the Museum of Archaeology and Anthropology.
