Biographical and Other Notes

A landowner and avid collector of antiquities, who served as the first president of the British Archaeological Association. The portion of the family collection including silver objects and a modest selection of coins (including some from the important Sevington hoard) was sold by his son, William Denison, 1st Earl of Londesborough (Christies 4 July 1888), though some coins from the collection were disposed of through other channels
