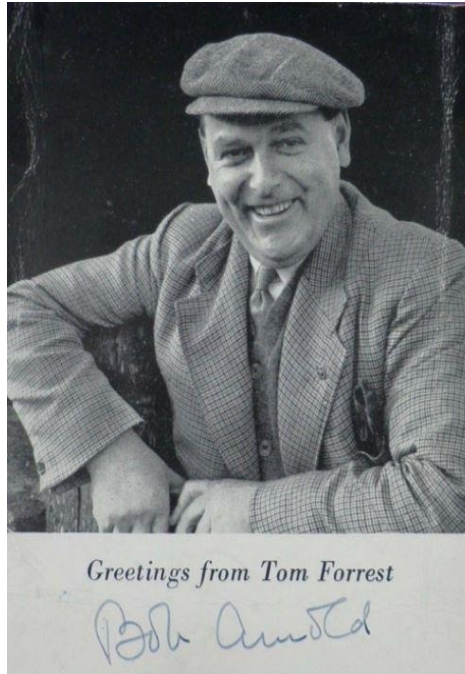

Biographical and Other Notes

Born in Asthall, Oxfordshire. Employed first as a butcher's boy then a white line painter for Oxfordshire County Council via which he and his accent became well known. A short spell on BBC Radio *'In the Cotswolds'* was followed by serving as RAF ground crew during the war and then in 1951 he became the voice of Tom Forrest in the Archers. Lived in Burford, Oxfordshire for most of his life. Over 40 years he formed a comprehensive series of Roman Silver coins (1st and 2nd C AD). 1800 pieces were sold at Glendining's 17-17 June 1969 and 21 November 1984.
