**Biographical and Other Notes**

Born in Barrow in Furness. After school he worked for British Rail. National Service was spent in the north of England and in Germany. By 1955 he was stationmaster at East Langton, Leicestershire. After the 1966 Beeching cuts he moved to the Paper and Printing division of British Rail. He founded the Crewe & District Coin and Medal Society (1966), The Token Congress (1982) and the South Cheshire (Crewe) George Formby Ukulele Society (1994). As well as *The First Dictionary of Par Numismatica* (1991) he authored several other books on tokens and local (Cheshire) history and many articles.
