### Biographical and Other Notes

He was born in 1941 to a military family in Gloucester. Studied Economics and accounting at Bristol University. He collected coins from a very early age, rediscovering the hobby whilst at Bristol. Member of many Numismatic Societies as he moved around the country. Very active at collecting and researching local tokens. He qualified as a chartered accountant and later became a lecturer in Economics at Highbury Technical College, Portsmouth, later moving to Swindon College as Head of Business Studies. Took early retirement in 1993 and became a full-time dealer in coins tokens and medals. A regular at Token Congress, organizing the 2002 event in Cheltenham. Stock sold DNW 19 March 2003.
