Biographical and Other Notes

Born and grew up in Bath, degree at the University of Birmingham in the School of Ancient History and Archaeology. Birmingham City Museum 1962-84. Introduced to tickets, checks and passes by R.N.P. Hawkins. Moved to be director of Lincolnshire Museums and Art Gallery. Catalogued the G.F. Hill bequest of Lincolnshire pennies in SCBI 27, 1981. Several token booklets produced during his lifetime and posthumously from his notes along with SCBI 42 (South Eastern Mints) 1992.
