Biographical and Other Notes

Born in Stourbridge, Worcestershire. Trained at Stourbridge School of Art and Crafts, and later joined the typesetting department at a local newspaper. Two years of National Service in Egypt coincided with his hobbies of archaeology and photography. Moved to another job in Birmingham (teacher at Halesowen?) in 1962 and in 1970 started his own business selling tokens, ancient and hammered coins. George Berry introduced him to coin collecting in 1958. He formed a good collection of coins of the English Civil War and a very good collection of Worcestershire 17th C tokens. Gave many talks to numismatic societies and wrote many articles for Coins, Coin Monthly, Coins & Medals etc.
