Biographical and Other Notes

Started work at Birmingham City Museum in 1958, moving to the Department of Coins and Medals at the BM in 1963, and becoming Assistant Keeper in 1965. She retired in 1997. Her primary area of interest was Anglo-Saxon coins and all related scientific studies including monetary history and metallurgy. Her 70th birthday year was celebrated with the publication of a book of essays integrating an understanding of numismatics, monetary studies, archaeology and history, with papers from 30 of her colleagues, collaborators and former students
