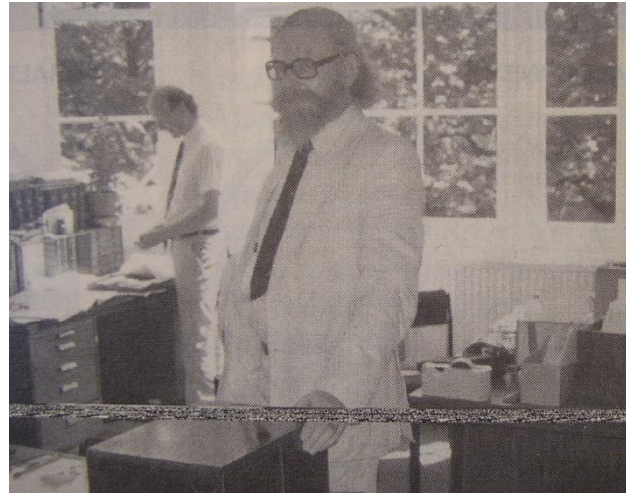

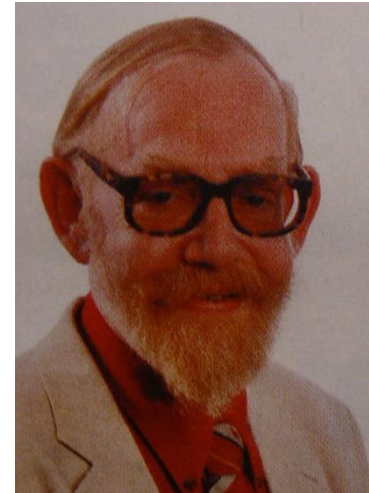

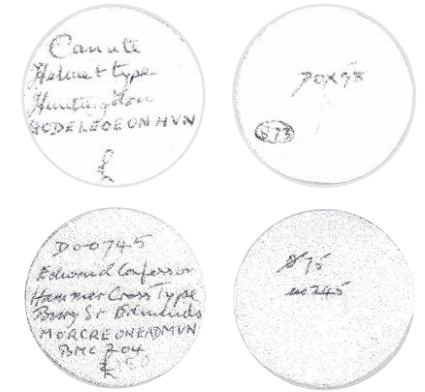

Biographical and Other Notes

Born and lived in Brighton, collected general British coins from his teens. Fifteen years working in Post Office audit teams in London. The Saturday morning club in Brighton introduced him to many important names and the specialized in coins of Charles I. He joined Baldwins in 1972 where he became the go-to person for British hammered coins and friend to many collectors. He catalogued many major collections and the 'Thames Hoard' and then joined DNW in 2002, retiring in 2007. He published several articles and a few significant papers. His unfinished work on Jacobite Medals and other material will hopefully be completed.
