Biographical and Other Notes

Born in Kuala Lumpur, he came to England just before the Japanese invasion. In 1938 he was evacuated to a school in Cornwall, where he started and interest in Kent tokens. He returned to King's School in Canterbury in 1945 as a King's Scholar. National service was in the RAF, converting to jets in Canada. Following University he trained as a vet, ultimately having his own practice. He held high positions in several veterinary organisations.
