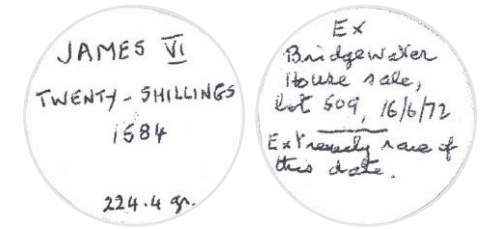


Murray, John Kenneth Ronald ('Jock') Lieutenant-Colonel

Biographical and Other Notes

Lived at Uckington, Cheltenham, Gloucestershire. Cheltenham NS, RNS and BNS. Author of many articles on Scottish numismatics in BNJ, NC, SNC and SCMB. Collection of coins of the Eastern Baltic States presented to the Ashmolean Museum in 1977. English milled gold and other collections sold at Glendining's 1 October 1952. The main collection of 828 Scottish gold and silver coins from David I to 'James VIII' in 462 lots at Spink's, 29 April 1987. Small residue retained by Mrs. Murray, later sold privately and in a small group by Baldwin 9 May 2001.
