Biographical and Other Notes

At the age of 20, in September 1969 I started work as assistant to Howard Linecar, the Manager of the Book Dept. Howard had been with the company since the mid-1930s, and I learned much from “HL” as he was affectionately called by his many friends.

From the late 1970s, until I resigned from the company in 2006, I edited most of the well-respected Spink publications, often as many as 12 titles annually, and many internationally - recognized standard works of reference. I also edited the famous Numismatic Circular, published since 1892.

In 2006 I resigned from the old company and started my own business dealing in rare and out of print books, catalogues and manuscripts relating to all aspects of the subject.
