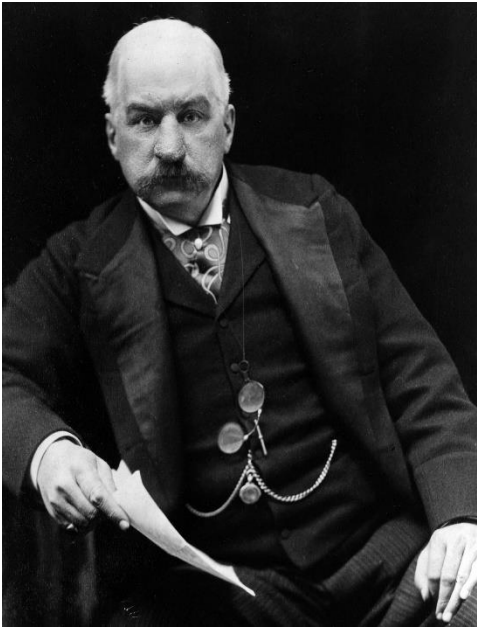

## Biographical and Other Notes

An American financier and banker who dominated corporate finance on Wall Street. Morgan was a notable collector of books, pictures, paintings, clocks and other art objects, many loaned or given to the Metropolitan Museum of Art. Bought the Sir John Evans collection en bloc from Spink, then selected coins for his own collection and sold the remainder back through Spink: where a large portion passed into the hands of P. W. P. Carlyon-Britton. The rest was sold through SNC.
