Biographical and Other Notes

Educated at Haileybury College and Jesus College, Cambridge. Member of Parliament for Hitchin from 1974 to 1983, and for North Hertfordshire from 1983 to 1992. He sat in the House of Lords from 1992 to 2015. Interested in Scottish coinage from his time at school and wrote *The Scottish Coinage* (Spink & Son, 1955). He also wrote *English Coins 1180-1551* (Spink, 2009). His collection of Scottish coins was stolen in 2007 (unrecovered) and his English collection was sold through Spink in five parts: 22nd March 2016, 28th June 2016, 26th September 2016, 29th November 2016, 28th March 2017 and some oddments on 5th July 2017. As a treasury minister involved with the introduction of the £2 coin.
