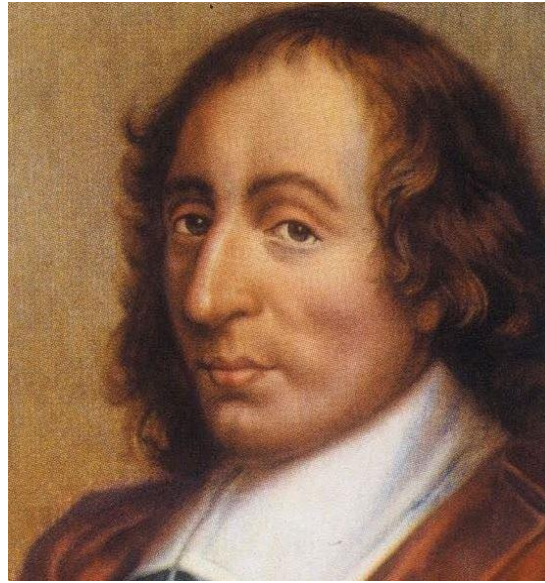


## Brerewood, Edward

(c.1565-1613)



### Biographical and Other Notes

Also Bryerwood. Antiquary, Mathematician, and professor of astronomy. Three times mayor of Chester. Member of the Elizabethan Society of Antiquaries. His manuscript study of ancient coins, *De ponderibus, et petiis veterum nummorum eorumque cum recentioribus* was published posthumously by his nephew Robert Brerewood in 1614. Also wrote a book *Enquiries touching the Diversity of Languages, and Religions through the cheife Parts of the World*, again published in 1614.
